Dr. Barros is a professor of Pain Management and Palliative Care and the Vice Head of the Anesthesiology Department of the Botucatu Medical School. He is a member of the Director Council of the Sao Paulo State

Anesthesiology Society, and the Treasurer of it. He has a huge interest in teaching medical students and he is the actual Scientific Coordinator for Medical School Pain Leagues affiliated at the Brazilian Society for Study of Pain, chapter of the International Association for Study of Pain – IASP. He has increasing interest in Palliative Care and, for this reason, has promoted many Palliative Care workshops held on the Brazilian Anesthesiology Society congresses and meetings, as well have given lectures in scientific events in Brazil, Uruguay, Bolivia and Dominican Republic. He has published many papers in Brazilian and in some international journals, as has presented many studies on scientific events worldwide.

Dr. Barros graduated in medicine at Federal University of Para, and pursued residency training in Anesthesiology in Santos city, in a public hospital. He was a Research Student of Physiology at the Kagawa Medical School, Japan, where he entered the PhD program, but did not accomplished it. Once back to Brazil, he pursed residency training in Pain Management and Palliative Care at Botucatu Medical School, where he earned MsD and PhD degrees. Actually he is member of some committees related to research and teaching at the Botucatu Medical School and is the mentor of MsC and PhD students.
